

The 33rd Annual Cumberland Fair Pumpkin and Squash Weigh-Off

This year's Cumberland Fair will host the 33rd Annual Maine State Pumpkin and Squash Weigh-In. Each year promises much anticipation and excitement to see who will grow record-breaking massive gourds!

Weigh-off

- 1. All judges' decisions are final. All judges will be responsible to have a complete knowledge of all rules and how to implement them fairly. It will be necessary to have a current copy of the rules present at each site in public view so anyone may reference them.
- Growers are to aid and assist the site in running the weigh-off upholding the integrity of the weigh-off site.
 The Cumberland Farmer's Club representative and site coordinator are to be in charge of the gathering of registration, money, weights, measurements, and other information deemed necessary. All decisions made by the Cumberland Farmer's Club are final.
- 4. Site coordinators, growers, and the Cumberland Farmer's Club representatives, and site representatives are to work as a team to ensure each site is as accommodating to the growers, site, and Cumberland Farmer's Club as possible, upholding the values of fair competition.
- 5. The Cumberland Farmer's Club Giant Pumpkin/Squash weighoffs are open to anyone wishing to participate without prejudice. All growers must comply with all rules and regulations set forth at the weigh-off site they wish to participate in. Any rules the Cumberland Farmer's Club wishes to have must be fair and impartial for all growers. 6. The above-mentioned representatives will also assume responsibility of ensuring the integrity of the fruits and that scales have been calibrated by a recognized weights and measurement business or government prior to the weigh-off.

- 1. The entry must be grown, cared for from seed to harvest, and exhibited by the grower. In case of an emergency the site coordinator, grower representative, and site representative will make a decision on the validity of the excuse.
- and site representative will make a decision on the validity of the excuse.

 2. Number of entries shall be limited to the following in the name of fairness:

 Giant Pumpkins Adult: One entry per family. Giant Squash Adult: One entry per family. Giant Pumpkins Child (ages 8-15): One entry per child; limit 3 children per family. Giant Squash Child (ages 8-15): One entry per child; limit 3. children per family. Jack-O-Lanterns Adult: One entry per family. Jack-O-Lanterns Child (under 15): One entry per child; limit 3 children per family.

 3. Judges for a weigh-off will consist of the club/grower representative, site coordinator and site representative or 2 experienced growers. The
- site coordinator, and site representative, or 2 experienced growers. The two judges for the growers will be appointed by the Cumberland Farmers Club representatives. If any judge has an entry that is in question or cannot be present the day of the weigh-off, they will be excused from the judge's panel and another grower will be appointed in their place.

 4. All specimens must be weighed on a certified scale. A certified scale is one that
- has been inspected and certified by a Federal Governmental Agency and must have a current certification sticker attached to the scale. Scales that have been certified by
- a local government agency for commercial purposes are also acceptable scales. 5. No foreign material (i.e. fungicides, caulking, skin additives, etc.) will be permitted in the weighing of any fruit. Vines must be trimmed to within one inch of the stem of the fruit. The judges have the right to inspect any and all fruit before weights and measurements become official. Refusal of any inspection to any entry will cause the entry to be classified "exhibition" only.
- 6. The specimen must be sound, healthy, and undamaged. Entries must be free of rot, holes or cracks through to the cavity and serious soft spots.
- A. If a soft spot is superficial and does not go through to the cavity of the fruit, it will be judged as an official entry.
- B. The judges reserve the right to prove cracks, holes, and to dig out soft spots to judge a fruit official or not. Before the judges can execute any of the previous, they must have the grower present.
- 7. Any fruit that has been weighed at a previous weigh-off, be it a GPC or independent event, will not be considered for prize money and shall be classified Exhibition at the Cumberland Fair Weigh-off.
- 8. All entries, except Jack-O-Lanterns, must arrive on a pallet for ease of handling by Cumberland Fair personnel.
- 9. Giant pumpkin/squash must weigh at least 100 pounds to enter.
- 10. All entries must stay on the fairgrounds for the entire duration of the fair.

 11. Fruit will be accepted at designated gate only from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, September 26
- 12. Fruit will be weighed beginning at 9:30 a.m. Sunday, September 26.
 13. Jack-O-Lanterns may be moved to inside the Exhibition Hall after weigh-off.

Color Requirements and Prize Money

- 1. A. Squash will be classified as follows 100% of the following colors or color combinations: green, blue, and gray. The surface area of the fruit as grown in the garden, not including the portion that was in contact with, or close proximity to the ground. This area will include the area between the ribs, around the stem, and the blossom end. This will not include any netting (canteloping) or any discoloration caused by the close proximity to, or the area on the ground. B. Pumpkins will be all fruit not classified as squash.
- 2. In the event of a tie of two or more places, all entries that are tied will have the prize money for the places that are tied, added together then split equally amongst the places that are involved.
- 3. Winner will be the heaviest pumpkin or squash by weight.
 4. All fruit entered shall be grown within the borders of the State of Maine to be eligible for premiums. The Cumberland Farmers Club and its officially sanctioned site shall not be held liable for compensation, loss, damage, or injury to any person, exhibit, or personal property. All premiums are not guaranteed. Money payouts will be contingent upon receipt of sponsorship amounts received.

- 2. No article may be exhibited a second time.
- 3. Articles must have been finished, grown or raised the same year they are exhibited. EXCEPTION 2021 ONLY prior year will be accepted. 4. Articles must be made by the person under whose name they are
- exhibited.

- 5. All articles exhibited must be CLEAN and free of odors, pet hairs, stains, etc. or will be disqualified.
- 6. When there is only one entry in a class, it will be given the premium considered worthy by the judges.
- 7. Exhibits by people with disabilities invited. Please specify as such on the entry blank.
- 8. Hall Superintendent may refuse items, or judges may disqualify items, not acceptable for exhibit or that do not comply with the rules and regulations.
- 9. No part of one exhibit shall interfere with any part of another exhibit. 10. Care will be taken to prevent loss or damage, but the CUMBERLAND FARMERS' CLUB WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INJURY
- 11. Adults are considered as individuals ages 16 and up. Youth are considered as individuals ages 15 and under. Youth may enter in any category unless specifically listed as an adult category.
- 12. Additional rules may be listed under specific classes.

14.103 Maine Wild Blueberry Muffin Contest (Adult, 16 & over)

2 C flour

1/3 C sugar 1/4 C light brown sugar

2 tsp baking powder

3/4 tsp salt

3/4 C whole or low-fat milk

2 eggs
5 TBSP melted butter
1 C (1/2 pint) wild Maine blueberries

INSTRUCTIONS:

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Grease 12 cup muffin tin. Measure flour, sugar, brown sugar, baking powder and salt into bowl. Mix. Whisk milk, eggs, and butter in small bowl. Pour egg mixture into flour mixture and gently stir until dry ingredients are just moistened. (Do not overmix!) Fold in the blueberries. Spoon the batter into the muffin tins. Bake until golden brown and springy to the touch, 18-22 minutes (or 15 in convection oven). Cool 5 minutes before removing from tins. 14.104 Maine Blueberry Drop Cookies contest (Youth, 15 & under) Ingredients:

2 cups all-purpose flour

2 teaspoons baking powder

½ teaspoon salt

½ cup shortening

¼ cup milk

1 egg 1 cup white sugar

1 teaspoon almond extract

1 ½ teaspoons lemon zest

1 cup wild Maine blueberries

Instructions: In a large mixing bowl, cream shortening, sugar, egg milk, almond extract, and lemon zest. Mix well after addition of each ingredient. Combine flour, baking powder and salt. And blend into the sugar mixture. Fold in blueberries. Cover and chill for 4 hours. Preheat oven to 375 F. Drop dough by teaspoonful onto greased cookie sheets, about 1 ½ inches apart. Bake 12-15 minutes. Let cookies cool on cookie sheets for a few minutes before transferring to wire racks to cool completely.

BAKEWELL CREAM BAKING CONTESTS

Bakewell Cream is a variety of baking powder developed by Bangor, Maine chemist Byron H. Smith in response to a shortage of cream of tartar in the U.S. during World War II. It is sold throughout the U.S. but is most popular in the state of Maine. The current manufacturer, the New England Cupboard, is the successor to Byron Smith's original company. Their Bakewell-related products include the original baking powder in several varieties and a biscuit mix, all sold through several channels under the "Bakewell Cream" label. All varieties include acid sodium pyrophosphate, which was Byron Smith's original unique ingredient; those sold as "baking powder" also include sodium bicarbonate.

4 cups flour

4 teaspoons Bakewell Cream*

2 teaspoons baking soda

1 teaspoon salt

½ cup (8 tablespoons) cold butter

1½ cups cold milk

*NOT Bakewell Cream Baking Powder; only plain Bakewell Cream Instructions:

Preheat the oven to 475°. Lightly grease a baking sheet, or line with parchment. Whisk the dry ingredients together in a bowl. Work in the butter till the mixture is crumbly; some larger, pea-sized pieces of butter may remain intact. Add the milk, stirring till everything is moistened. Turn the dough out onto a clean work surface (a silicone mat works well) and fold it over once or twice. Pat it into a 34"-Thick Square, rectangle, or circle. Cut the biscuits with a round or square cutter. Place them on the prepared baking sheet. Brush their tops with milk or melted butter, if desired. Bake for 5 minutes, then turn off the oven. Leave in the oven for an additional 5 to 10 minutes, till they are golden brown. Yield: about 1 ½ dozen big (2 1/2") biscuits, or about 32 smaller (1 1/2") biscuits. 

Preheat the oven to 375°F. Lightly grease a 12-cup muffin tin, or line it with papers and spray the insides of the papers. In a small bowl, cover the raisins (or craisins) with hot water, and set them aside to soak while you assemble the rest of the recipe. In a large bowl, whisk together the flour, sugar, baking soda, spices, and salt. Stir in the carrots, apple, coconut, and nuts. In a separate bowl, beat together the eggs, oil, vanilla, and orange juice. Add to the flour mixture and stir until evenly moistened. Drain the raisins (craisins) and stir them in. Divide the batter among the wells of the prepared pan (they will be full almost to the top; that's OK). Bake the muffins for 25 to 28 minutes, until they're nicely domed, and a cake tester inserted in the center of one of the inner muffins comes out clean. Remove from the oven, let cool for 5 minutes in their pan on a rack, then turn out of pans to finish cooling. Wrap any leftovers airtight, and store at room temperature for several days: freeze for longer storage. Yield: 12 muffins.

Preheat the oven to 400°F. Lightly grease (or line with parchment) two baking sheets. The mixture will become lighter, and lighter-colored, as you beat; this is the result of air being absorbed. Beat in the vanilla, cream of tartar, baking soda (or baking powder, in place of the cream of tartar and soda), and salt, then add the flour, mixing slowly until combined. Place about 1/2 cup cinnamon-sugar in an 8" or 9" round cake pan. Drop the soft dough by tablespoonsful into the pan with the sugar, about 6 to 8 balls at a time. Gently shake the pan to coat the dough balls with sugar. Place the cookies on the prepared baking sheets, leaving about 1 1/2" between them. Using the bottom of a glass, flatten each cookie until it's about 1/2" thick. Repeat until you have used up all the dough. Bake the snickerdoodles for 11 to 12 minutes, reversing the position of the pans (top to bottom, and back to front) midway through. Remove the cookies from the oven once they are set and just starting to turn golden. Transfer them to a rack to cool completely.
